The following list includes the minimum amount and type of first aid supplies accepted by OSHA for a small logging crew of two or three employees.

## **Instructions for requesting emergency assistance which include:**

- Emergency phone numbers
- directions to the worksite
- Your Name
- Your Phone/Radio Number
- Your Location
- Nature of the Accident
- Number Injured
- Time of Accident
- Condition of Victim(s)
- Name/Description of person who will meet ambulance

## KIT CHECKLIST

Gauze Pads (at least 4"x4")
Two large gauze pads (at least 8" x 10")
Box of Adhesive bandages (band-aids)
One package of gauze roller bandage at least 2" wide
Two triangular bandages
Wound cleaning agent such as sealed, moistened towelletes
Scissors
Blanket
Tweezers
Adhesive tape
Two elastic wraps
Splint
Resuscitation equipment such as resuscitation bag, airway or pocket mask*
3 pair of latex gloves *
1 barrier (surgical mask) *
1 pair of safety glasses or goggles *
6 plastic bags for disposal blood-soaked items*

\*These items constitute a Biohazard Kit and can be included within your first aid kit or can be in a separate kit. This Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) will help to meet OSHA standard for exposure to Blood-borne Pathogens.

IMPORTANT NOTE: This overview explains the minimum first aid kit of OSHA's Logging Operations Final Rule. We strongly suggest you include other first aid items in your kit depending on the nature and hazards of your logging job.
