

For kids like Eli.

2020 was a year when time stood still. As many people grappled with how to adjust to isolation, quarantining, and masking, Eli's family faced an additional and even more frightening reality when their son was diagnosed with leukemia.

Eli had just celebrated his fifth birthday when his mom started to notice the bruises. His daycare had re-opened after being shut down because of the initial pandemic, and she thought the bruises were from playing outside. However, the bruises didn't fade. In fact, they got worse. Add to the equation that a family friend commented that Eli looked pale. It was a comment that shook his mom to her core, and she



started to worry. She, too, started to notice that he was pale and had some darker circles under his eyes.

Eli's family's worst fears were realized when he was diagnosed with leukemia. After his initial diagnosis, Eli spent two weeks in a Portland hospital before being transferred to Northern Light Eastern Maine Medical Center's Raish Peavey Haskell Children's Cancer and Treatment Center in Brewer. "When I was first told that his treatment would be for two years, I remember sitting there thinking, wow, two entire years," shares his mom. She adds, "Honestly, these last two years have felt like 200 years and 20 seconds all at the same time."

During these last two years, Eli has never complained about his diagnosis, treatments, or not feeling well. He's kept a good attitude, and now that he's completed treatment, he's shared that he wants to pay it forward by teaching other kids who are newly diagnosed how to take their medicine.

Looking back, his mom shares, "2020 was challenging enough with the Covid scare. Add in the immense changes that Eli was facing with his diagnosis, and it was not only extremely challenging, but it was also terrifying. Eli took it all like a champ and we've all been inspired by Eli's bravery."
